



Early Childhood and Family Services (ECFS) Early Intervention Specialist/Teacher of the Deaf Brewer, Maine

Become part of a family-centered team supporting children who are deaf or hard of hearing, birth through age five. This full time, 205-day outreach position is based in Brewer, Maine.

Responsibilities include:

- Home visits and facilitating discussions related to hearing levels, communication and language development, communication options/opportunities and overall child development for families of children who are deaf or hard of hearing, birth to age five.
- Providing Special Instruction – primary service provision of early intervention.
- Collaborating with early childhood agencies and providers.
- Observing and providing on-site consultation to early childhood programs.
- Directing Specially Designed Instruction to preschoolers.
- Consulting, in-service training, and support for teachers, caregivers and professionals.
- Monitoring communication and language development through a variety of assessments.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Eligibility for Maine Teacher of the Deaf certification or Speech Language Pathologist Certification
- Masters' Degree preferred.
- Educational background and experience in early childhood and parent education.
- Prior experience teaching children who are Deaf and Hard of Hearing.
- Willingness to support parent choices.
- Experience in supporting listening and spoken language outcomes.
- Fluency in American Sign Language or willingness to learn.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Willingness to travel.
