Purpose of Announcement: To fill a full-time, 200 day, Speech Language Pathologist position to work with deaf and hard of hearing children in the Preschool and K-12 programs at the Maine Educational Center for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing/Governor Baxter School for the Deaf.

Job Description: The successful candidate will work collaboratively with our interdisciplinary teams to provide children with speech and language services per each Individual Education Plan (IEP). Other duties include:

- Planning meetings and Individual Education Plan (IEP) Team meetings for students on their caseload.
- Adhering to all timelines.
- Written recommendations and written reports must be provided for each IEP meeting.
- Providing therapy during the school year and for the four week/3 day a week extended school year program in July.
- Evaluations as requested.

Minimum Requirements: Master's Degree in Speech/Language Pathology and a Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology. This person must hold a valid Speech Pathologist license as issued by the Maine State Board of Examiners on Speech Pathology and Audiology. Experience with Listening and Spoken Language and working with children with cochlear implants preferred. Fluency in American Sign Language preferred or willingness to learn required.

Applicants must have knowledge of the principles and methods of speech/language pathology including diagnostic, therapeutic and evaluative strategies. They must also have the ability to plan and conduct programs (individual and classroom-based) of speech/ language therapy.
