- Supports hearing assistance technology usage
- Facilitates play with children
- Follows through with suggestions from the teachers
- Assists teachers with classroom material preparation
- Provides one on one support to some children throughout the day and works with children with additional special needs
- Follows through with IEP goals and data collection for children in the program
- Collaborates as part of a strong early childhood team

Minimum Qualifications

- Three years of post-secondary education in an education-related field
- Fluency in American Sign Language and knowledge of Deaf Culture is preferred
- Experience working with children using listening and spoken language for communication
- Experience working with children with additional special needs
- Experience working with augmentative communication
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with children, professionals, and families
- Educational Technician II or III certification from the State of Maine, Dept. of Education
