The Maine Educational Center for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing/Governor Baxter School for the Deaf is seeking a highly motivated individual who possesses strong communication skills, technical aptitude and organizational qualities to fill a full time position of Maintenance Mechanic.

Primary Responsibilities Include:

- Repair and maintain building structures (walls, woodwork, doors windows and floors) to ensure structural stability and safety.
- Scraping, filling, sanding, priming, and painting surfaces, both interior and exterior
- Open and assess physical plant daily prior to staff arrival, lock up at days end
- Prepare meeting rooms and respond to custodial requests
- Cleaning, maintaining, and servicing hand tools, machinery, equipment and work area to maintain safety standards, prolong equipment life and maintain equipment availability
- Operating snow removal and road maintenance equipment to clear walkways, driveways, parking lots and roads
- Maintaining grounds including lawn mowing, tree and branch removal, weeding, striping parking lot, filling pot holes, etc.
- Complete minor repairs/maintenance of heating, ventilating, plumbing and electrical systems with direction from the Maintenance Supervisor.

Required Skills and Qualifications:

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Minimum of 5 years' experience in general maintenance
- Ability to use basic power tools, including saws, drills, lawn care equipment, etc.
- Knowledge of State and Federal laws relating to the operation of school facilities and worker safety
- Excellent verbal communication skills
- Willing to travel occasionally to other locations in Maine
- Ability to multi-task and work independently
- Willingness to learn American Sign Language
- Current CHRC (fingerprint) certificate required
