Job Description

- Provides classroom support to the early childhood program teachers and children and facilitates communication between children, supports hearing assistance technology usage, facilitates play with children, and follows through with suggestions from the teachers
- Assists teachers with classroom material preparation. Provides one on one support to some children throughout the day and works with children with additional special needs. Follows through with IEP goals and data collection for children in the program. The Education Technician III will be part of a strong early childhood team

Minimum Qualifications

- Three years of post-secondary education in an education-related field
- Fluency in American Sign Language and knowledge of Deaf Culture is preferred
- Experience working with children using listening and spoken language for communication
- Experience working with children with additional special needs
- Experience working with augmentative communication
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with students, professionals and families
