The Maine Educational Center for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing/ Governor Baxter School for the Deaf is seeking to fill a full time, 193 day, school year Speech Language Pathologist position. The Public School Outreach Program is committed to providing support to public school personnel regarding communication and literacy development, access to classroom communication and curriculum, the importance of self-advocacy skills and the social needs of students who are deaf and hard of hearing. This position will provide consultation, evaluations, and direct speech services to students.

Job Description: The successful candidate will work collaboratively with the public school outreach team and professionals in mainstream settings to evaluate students, develop appropriate IEP goals, support programming efforts and provide staff development when needed.

Minimum Requirements: Master's Degree in Speech/Language Pathology and a Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology. This person must hold a valid Speech Pathologist license as issued by the Maine State Board of Examiners on Speech Pathology and Audiology. Applicants must have knowledge of the principles and methods of speech/language pathology including diagnostic, therapeutic and evaluative strategies used with students who are deaf and hard of hearing. Skills with Listening and Spoken Language, a variety of hearing assistive technology and cochlear implants preferred.
