The Maine Educational Center for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing/ Governor Baxter School for the Deaf is seeking to fill a half-time, 185-day school year Speech Language Pathologist position to work with deaf and hard of hearing children in grades K-12.

Job Description: The successful candidate will provide students in grades K-12, with speech and language services as prescribed by each Individual Education Plan (IEP). This person will work collaboratively with teachers and other colleagues to provide therapy. The therapist must attend IEP Team meetings for students on their caseload. Recommendations and written reports must be provided for each IEP meeting.

Minimum Requirements: A Master's Degree in Speech/Language Pathology and a Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology are required. This person must hold a valid Speech Pathologist license as issued by the Maine State Board of Examiners on Speech Pathology and Audiology. Applicants must have knowledge of the principles and methods of speech/language pathology including diagnostic, therapeutic and evaluative strategies used with students who are deaf and hard of hearing. They must also have the ability to plan and conduct programs (individual and classroom-based) of speech/language therapy.
