Job Title: Speech/Language Pathologists (Two ½ time positions)

**Purpose of Announcement:** To fill two, ½ time, 200 day, school year Speech Language Pathologist positions. The person in these positions will work with students who are deaf or hard of hearing in the Preschool or K-12 programs.

**Job Description:** The successful candidate will work collaboratively with our interdisciplinary teams to provide children with speech and language services per each Individual Education Plan (IEP). Other duties include planning meetings and IEP Team meetings for students on their caseload. Adhere to all timelines. Written recommendations and written reports must be provided for each IEP meeting. Providing therapy during the school year and for the four week/3 day a week extended school year program in July. Evaluations as requested.

**Minimum Requirements:** Master's Degree in Speech/Language Pathology and a Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology. This person must hold a valid Speech-Language Pathologist license as issued by the State of Maine, Dept. of Professional and Financial Regulation. Experience with Listening and Spoken Language and working with children with cochlear implants preferred. Proficiency in American Sign Language and Cued Language preferred. Applicants must have knowledge of the principles and methods of speech/language pathology including diagnostic, therapeutic and evaluative strategies. They must also have the ability to plan and conduct programs (individual and classroom based) of speech language therapy.
