



Contract Interpreters Needed

The Maine Educational Center for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing/Governor Baxter School for the Deaf (MECDHH/GBSD) is seeking contract interpreters to work in their statewide programs. Interpreting assignments can range from, but are not limited to, administrative meetings, student and parent conferences, educational mainstreaming, in-services, IEP/ISP meetings, guest lectures, field trips, performing arts, and after school programs/sports. Immediate ongoing needs are at the Portland and Brewer site-based programs. MECDHH/GBSD interpreting services are for a variety of internal and external clients for in-person or remote requests.

We are seeking interpreters who have interpreter training and are licensed in the State of Maine. Interpreters with a minimum of one to five years interpreting experience are preferred. Contracted interpreters must demonstrate sufficient linguistic fluency and cognitive flexibility, advanced cultural knowledge of the Deaf community and its resources, and use standard practices and ethical decision making in accordance to the RID Code of Professional Conduct and the Standard Practice Papers. Additionally, we are seeking people who are excited to work with Deaf and hard of hearing students/staff and willing to be part of interdisciplinary teams while they provide access.
