Except as otherwise provided by law, by Maine Department of Education regulations, or by Board policy, *Robert's Rules of Order*, Revised (latest edition available) shall be used to resolve procedural uncertainties.

The Chair will rule on all questions pertaining to rules of order/ parliamentary procedure that may arise during a meeting of the Board or may appoint a member of the Board to serve as Parliamentarian. The appointment shall be subject to Board approval. The Parliamentarian should be familiar with *Robert's Rules* and able to advise the Board, as necessary, regarding parliamentary procedure

The role of the Parliamentarian shall be advisory only.

Procedural rules may be suspended at any time for the duration of any one meeting by majority vote of the Board members present.
